REFLECTING ON THE FEAST OF THE NATIVITY OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

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The liturgy enthusiastically celebrates Mary's Nativity and makes it one of the most appealing feasts of Marian devotion. We sing in today's Office: "Thy Nativity, O Virgin Mother of God, brings joy to the whole world, because from you came forth the Sun of Justice, Christ, our God." Mary's birth is a prelude to the birth of Jesus because it is the initial point of the realization of the great mystery of the Incarnation of the Son of God for the salvation of mankind. How could the birthday of the Mother of the Redeemer pass unnoticed in the hearts of the redeemed? The Mother proclaims the Son, making it known that He is about to come, that the divine promises, made centuries before, are to be fulfilled. The birth of Mary is the dawn of our redemption; her appearance projects a new light over all the human race: a light of innocence, of purity, of grace, a resplendent presage of the great light which will inundate the world when Christ, "lux mundi," the Light of the World, appears. Mary, preserved from sin in anticipation of Christ's merits, not only announces that the Redemption is at hand, but she bears the first fruits of it within herself; she is the first one redeemed by her divine Son. Through her, all-pure and full of grace, the Blessed Trinity at last fixes on earth a look of complacency, finding in her alone a creature in whom the infinite beauty of the Godhead can be reflected.

The birth of Jesus excepted, no other was so important in God's eyes or so fruitful for the good of humanity, as was the birth of Mary. Yet it has remained in complete obscurity. There is no mention of it in Sacred Scriptures and when we look for the genealogy of Jesus in the Gospel, we find only what refers to Joseph; we find nothing explicit about Mary's ancestry except the allusion to her descent from David. Our Lady's origin is wrapped in silence, as was her whole life. Thus, her birth speaks to us of humility. The more we desire to grow in God's eyes, the more we should hide ourselves from the eyes of creatures. The more we wish to do great things for God, the more we should labor in silence and obscurity. ☐

During the month of September, the church celebrates our Blessed Mother. This past year has been a quite a journey for me and my family. And with the grace of God, it has brought me into a deeper relationship with Our Lady, which I am ever so grateful for.

One of my favorite passages in the bible is the Canticle of Mary, or Magnificat, which can be found in Luke 1:46-55. *"And Mary said: My soul proclaims the greatness of the LORD; my spirit rejoices in God my savior. For He has looked upon his handmaid's lowliness; behold, from now on will all ages call me blessed. The Mighty One has done great things for me, and holy is His name."* I am always moved whenever I read or hear this passage. It reminds me that with God, anything is possible, and that His love and mercy for us is more than we could ever imagine! It was about this same time last year that my husband found a job after being laid off 11 months prior. It was through God's grace that we were able to survive financially with one income.

With my husband having secured a job, we were able to mentally relax and look forward to Our Lady of Guadalupe pilgrimage in December. October and November came and everywhere people were starting to get ready for the holidays – life was good! Our 8-year-old daughter even preemptively asked me, "Mommy, can we get puppy for Christmas?" I chuckled and said, "You know daddy doesn't want us to have pets right now because mommy and daddy would end up taking caring of it . . . maybe when you're older." She stopped for a moment and then excitedly asked "Well, what about a baby?" I couldn't help but laugh out loud (LOL)! I laughed and said to her "I don't know about that sweetie . . . we'll see . . . whatever God wants!"

Ever since we had gotten married, I would track my cycles following the guidelines for Natural Family Planning. Years ago when our son was about 5 years old and our daughter was 3, I did start having that tug at my heart to have a third child. But at the time, my husband felt he

was not ready to have a third child, but that we would accept whatever God had planned for us. Although I had hoped for a third, it was not in God's plan for us.

Now with the hustle and bustle of Thanksgiving approaching I almost forgot that I had not gotten my period yet. I had been regular my whole life, but after turning 40, my periods would be irregular here and there. Nonetheless, we had been successful using natural family planning methods for the past 12 years. I decided to stop by the doctor's office on my way home from work that Wednesday before Thanksgiving. As I sat in the waiting room, I immediately thought of our Blessed Mother and said "Oh Mama Mary, please be with me now." I began praying the Hail Mary and continued it repeatedly throughout the whole time. Right away I felt a sense of calm and I knew Mama Mary was definitely with me, especially when I received the surprising test result!

The "surprise!" baby in my womb was truly a gift from God! I thanked God for this wonderful blessing and to Mama Mary for always interceding for us! I was reminded of her fiat and I asked her to help me to be the kind of mother she was. I want to be a model of complete faith and trust in the Lord and so I offered the child back to our Eternal Father, trusting Him and offering myself and my family to whatever His divine will was. I also asked our Blessed Mother to always watch over and guide this child that I was now carrying in my womb. I was both nervous and excited to tell my husband the news!

I was curious how he would react, but as always, he was cool, calm, and collected! Sure we were both kind of scared to be restarting this parenting race, but we knew that as long as we kept our family focused on putting God first, our Lord would take care of the rest. I was now offering my daily rosaries for this child and asking for the intercession of Mama Mary and Saint Elizabeth, especially since we were about to go on a trip. ☐


SPIRITUAL ENRICHMENT RECOMMENDED

Although crosses adorn our church, steeples and their likeness are printed, woven, or worn in variety of fashionable way -- only a vague knowledge of the true meaning of the Cross comes to mind. What really happened at the cross? What does it mean to someone today? Is it all that important? At the cross of Christ, the three mortal enemies of humankind -- sin, death, and the devil -- were confronted and defeated by the Son of God. Jesus took our sins upon Himself at the cross.
